Artist Statement

The image of this piece belongs to a textile worker from the 1940s. It is about being proud of a job well done and a time when that meant something.

In the original photo she is working with jute. The "alpargata" is a traditional shoe, made in cotton canvas with a jute sole. I replaced the jute with wool, an emblematic raw material. It is blue, the color of our flag. The background is an old traditional motif in textiles made by hand by women on family looms.

Brandy Maslowski is a quiltmaker and textile artist who travels the world as a teacher, speaker, and NACQJ certified quilt judge. She is the author of children's picture book *Kristy's Quilt*. Her artwork and quilts explore meaningful themes in her life using the texture, colour and boundless possibilities of fabric, surface design and stitch. Gail Harker

Internationally known textile and fiber artist, author and educator Gail Harker, LCGI, studied art in Canada, England and Scotland. She completed the City & Guilds Design and Embroidery Diploma with Distinction and was awarded the Senior Qualification of Licentiate (LCGI) by the City & Guilds Institute in London, England. She has the equivalent of a Masters in textile and fiber art as well as contemporary embroidery. Gail has previously taught and verified City and Guilds Embroidery courses for various colleges in Great Britain. Since moving to the United States and for the past 29 years, she has taught and directed at the Arts Center she founded in Washington State, now located in La Conner, WA. Students have participated in Certificate and Diploma courses in Design and Embroidery from all parts of North America.



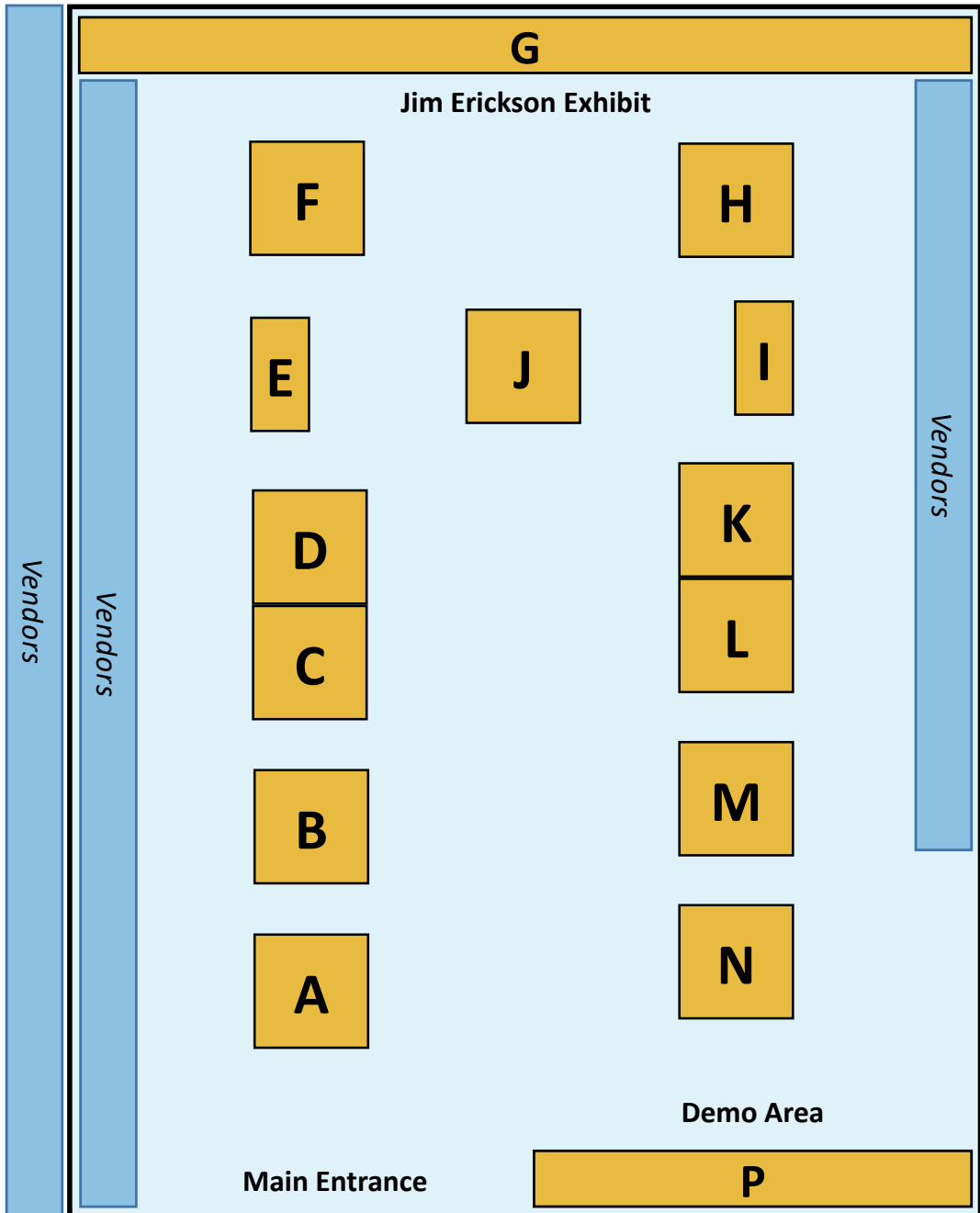
