



This class is for a first time quilter or a beginning quilter who would like to learn some skills with the tools of the trade.

During class students will rotary cut their fabrics and piece them into quilt blocks. The blocks will be used to create a quilt top and methods of finishing will be discussed. A mug rug will be bound in class to teach double fold French binding.

Supplies to be brought by students:

Sewing machine with needed accessories, a 1/4" foot is helpful but not required

Size 80/12 Microtex/Sharps sewing machine needles

Scissors for cutting fabric and trimming threads

Good quality 50 or 60 wt cotton or all-purpose thread

Pins

Rotary Cutter, 45mm or 60 mm blade size

Two Acrylic Rotary cutting rulers, one that is 24" long by any width, a second that is a minimum of 10 1/2" square

Self-healing Rotary cutting mat 18" x 24" size

Ingredients for Quilt Top:

1/3 yd each of 7 different coordinating 100% cotton quilt shop quality fabrics

Fabrics to finish quilt, we will not use these in class but you may want to purchase them at the same time so they match your quilt top.

Binding = 3/8 yard

Backing = 1 1/2 yards, with a minimum width of 42" usable inches
