## Kid's Summer Fiber Arts Camp Guidelines & Additional Information

- 1. We are committed to giving your children the most fun possible, while also teaching them about fiber art materials & techniques. Please make sure that your child wears comfortable clothing and foot wear that is safe and may possibly become dirty or even **permanently stained.** We will be using gloves and aprons/coverings but splashes and spills will inevitably happen.
- 2. Children are to bring a bag lunch each day. Beverages (lemonade, fruit punch, juices) will be provided by the Museum. Water will be made available throughout the entire day.
- 3. We will be working with a number of different materials and liquids. All materials have been researched to ensure we do not use anything that may be toxic or harmful to your children.
- 4. All children will be expected to treat others with respect and courtesy. If a child exhibits behavior that is unacceptable, staff will enforce a short time out, followed by discussion with parent at time of pick-up. In the unlikely event that unacceptable behavior continues, child will no longer be able to attend the Camp and no refund will be issued.
- 5. Children will be offered a snack with beverage. Choice may include fruit, cookies, crackers, or (depending on heat) perhaps even a popsicle! We will be avoiding any food items with peanuts or peanut related ingredients. Please make sure you have told us of any other possible food allergies on the Registration Form.
